Chapter 1: Introduction to Volume III

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INTRODUCTION

The 2012 South Florida Environmental Report (SFER) – Volume I provides an annual update on various environmental restoration projects and initiatives associated with the Everglades, Lake Okeechobee, Kissimmee Basin, and coastal systems. Expanding on this information, detailed permit-related annual reports and information pertaining to these regional restoration projects are presented in Volume III, Annual Permit Reports. These reports are prepared annually to comply with various permit-related reporting conditions required by permits issued by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) under the federal Clean Water Act (Section 404), or by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) under the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan Regulation Act (CERPRA), Everglades Forever Act (EFA), Northern Everglades and Estuaries Protection Program (NEEPP), and Environmental Resource Permitting (ERP) state statutes, as well as FDEP Emergency Orders in place during the reporting year.

Volume III consists of five chapters along with supporting appendices. In this volume, Chapter 1 provides an introduction to federal and state statutes that govern the permits issued to the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD or District) by the USACE and the FDEP, respectively, to construct and operate the regional restoration projects. This chapter also presents an overview of the annual permit reports included in this year's volume. Chapters 2 through 5 of this volume provide specific permit details, and this reporting is organized according to governing state statutes. These four chapters are entitled as follows:

- Chapter 2: Permitted Conditions Annual Reports for the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan Regulation Act Projects
- Chapter 3: Permitted Conditions Annual Reports for the Everglades Forever Act Projects
- Chapter 4: Permitted Conditions Annual Reports for the Northern Everglades and Estuaries Protection Program Projects
- Chapter 5: Permitted Conditions Annual Reports for the Environmental Resource Permitting Projects and Emergency Orders

If a specific project is operational, then a more detailed annual report with monitoring information is provided as a separate appendix. Otherwise, a project status update is presented in the relevant chapter. The reporting period covered by the annual permit reports and status updates are consistent with permit requirements, and includes Water Year 2011 (WY2011) (May 1, 2010–April 30, 2011), Calendar Year 2011 (CY2011) (January 1, 2011–December 31, 2011), or Fiscal Year 2011 (FY2011) (October 1, 2010–September 30, 2011).

The projects and programs described are designed to work together to benefit the ecosystem restoration projects, striving toward increased spatial extent of natural areas, enhanced habitat and functional quality, and improved native plant and animal species abundance and diversity. Most of the projects are multipurpose with objectives such as increased water storage, reduced seepage

from natural areas, and improved water quality. While no single project will significantly improve a regional ecosystem by itself, the cumulative regional environmental benefits as projects are implemented will improve the quantity, quality, timing, and distribution of water.

BACKGROUND - PERMITS

SECTION 404, CLEAN WATER ACT PERMITS

The Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 established the Section 404 Regulatory Program. Under this Act it is unlawful to discharge dredged or fill material into waters of the United States without first receiving authorization, usually a permit, from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, unless the discharge is covered under an exemption. The term "waters of the United States" defines the extent of geographic jurisdiction of the Section 404 program. The term includes such waters as rivers, lakes, streams, tidal waters, and most wetlands. A discharge of dredged or fill material involves the physical placement of soil, sand, gravel, dredged material, or other such materials into the waters of the United States.

CHAPTER 373.1502, FLORIDA STATUTES, PERMITS

The Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan Regulation Act was enacted by the Florida legislature [Chapter 373.1502, Florida Statutes (F.S.)] for the purpose of providing efficient and effective permitting of Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP) project components. CERPRA permits are in lieu of all other permits required in Chapters 373 and 403, F.S., except for permits that are under any delegated authority.

CHAPTER 373.4595, FLORIDA STATUTES, PERMITS

The Northern Everglades and Estuaries Protection Program was enacted by the Florida legislature (Chapter 373.4595, F.S.) to protect and restore surface water resources and achieve and maintain compliance with water quality standards in the Lake Okeechobee, St. Lucie River, and Caloosahatchee River Watersheds. Permits obtained pursuant to this section are in lieu of all other permits under this chapter or Chapter 403, except those issued under Section 403.0885, F.S.

CHAPTER 373.4592, FLORIDA STATUTES, PERMITS

The Everglades Forever Act was enacted by the Florida legislature (Chapter 373.4592, F.S.) to promote Everglades restoration and protection and to provide guidance for comprehensive and innovative solutions to issues of water quality, water quantity, hydroperiod, and invasion of exotic species which face the Everglades ecosystem.

CHAPTER 373, PART IV, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND TITLE 62, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, PERMITS

The Environmental Resource Permit Program [Chapter 62-330, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)] regulates activities involving the alteration of surface water flows. This includes new activities in uplands that generate stormwater runoff from upland construction, as well as dredging and filling in wetlands and other surface waters. ERP applications, and emergency orders, are processed by either the FDEP or one of the state's water management districts, in accordance with the division of responsibilities specified in operating agreements between the FDEP and the water management districts. The ERP Program is in effect throughout the state.

ANNUAL REPORTS OVERVIEW

REPORTING

Annually, the South Florida Water Management District is required to submit reports to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection regarding:

- Discussion of project status
- Conclusions regarding project success
- Problems encountered during the reporting period
- Actions taken to address the problems encountered

Chapters 2 through 5 of this volume present the annual permit reports and status updates required by the USACE permits (Section 404) and the FDEP permits (CERPRA, NEEPP, EFA, and ERP). **Table 1-1** provides an overview of permit information for projects covered during this reporting period and cross-references on where related information is reported in the 2012 SFER.
