- NTP Sep 29, 2017 with a contract duration of 620 days
- Change order 1 added 60 days to contract for H-pile modification
- Funding approved for PM support for \$186,757 at Oct Board
- SCADA funding of \$30k moved to project
- Project is 65% complete

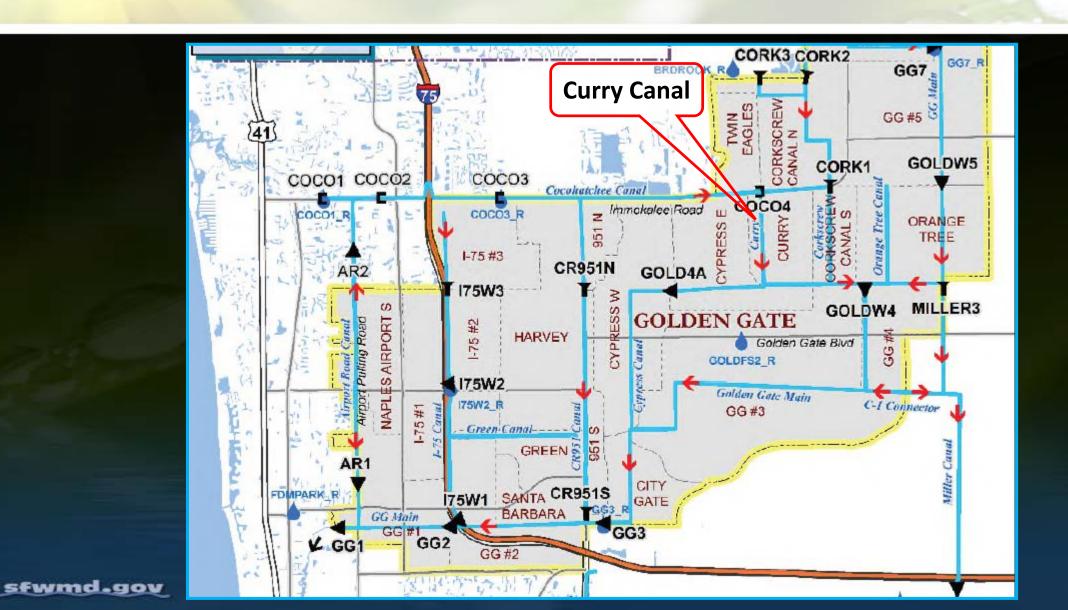

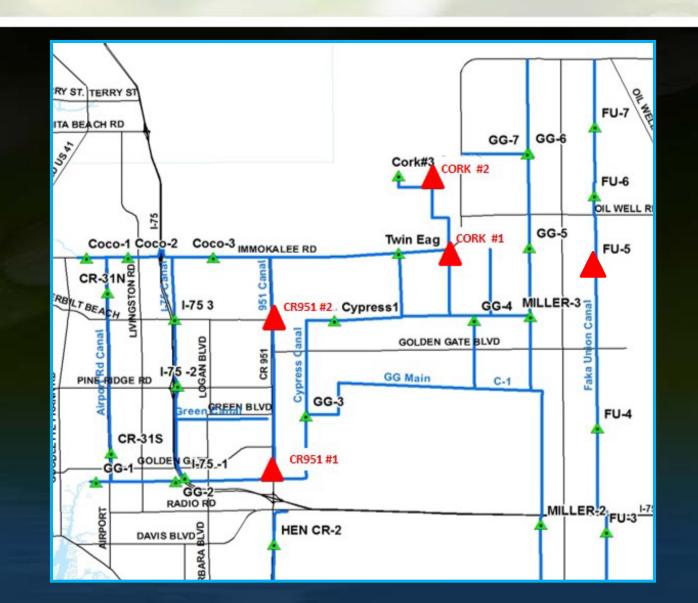


- Gate Operation Demonstration was conducted on December 20, 2018

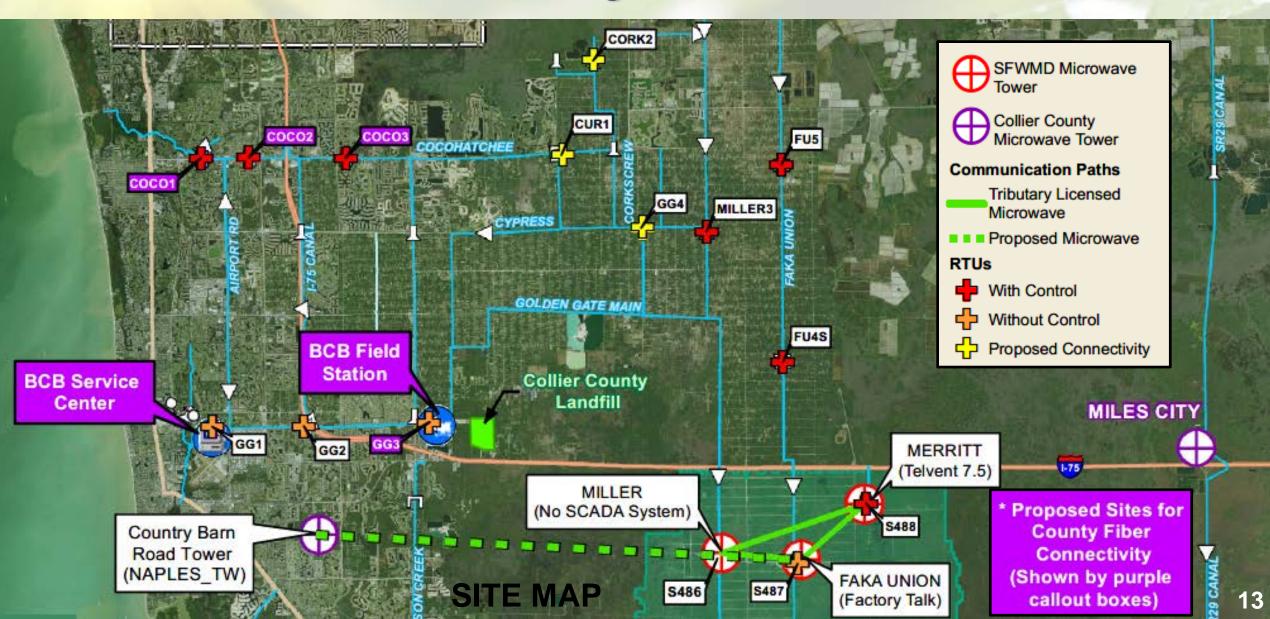
#### **Electrification & Remote Operations**

- FU5 New generator building & generator
- Design work order executed with CSA Central in Sep 2017, total work order amount \$433,979
- Final design submittal extended to Feb due to additional survey needs
- CORK2 easement requirements in negotiations
- Anticipated bid date in Jul 2019

#### **Remote Monitoring and Communication**

- Phase 2 includes telemetry installations and site work at the following structures: COCO1, COCO2, COCO3, FU4S, FU5, GG1
- Includes 6 concrete antenna poles, two antennas per pole, cables to shelters, and 24 gate level-indicator housings & conduit
- Level instrumentation to be purchased from and installed by SCADA need \$48k
- Contract executed with Current Connections for \$450,000 and 300 days
- Notice to Proceed Jul 10, 2018
- Project is 26% complete

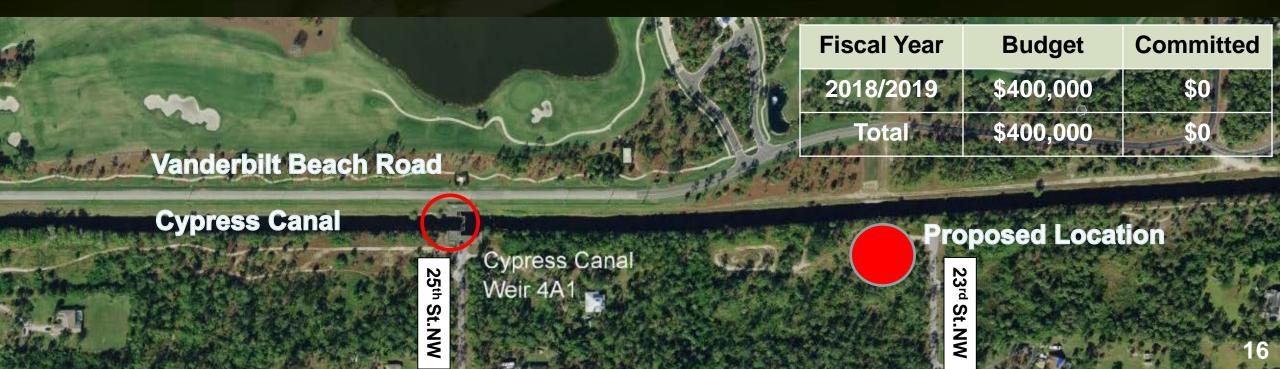
- Phase 3 scope includes:
  - Radios and Antennas at Miller 3, GG2, and GG4
  - Fiber installation at COCO1, COCO2, COCO3, GG3, BCB Service Center and BCB Field Station
  - Microwave link between County Barn Road Tower and FAKA Union Tower
  - Contracts for Base Stations, Antennas, Radios and Tower Analysis executed

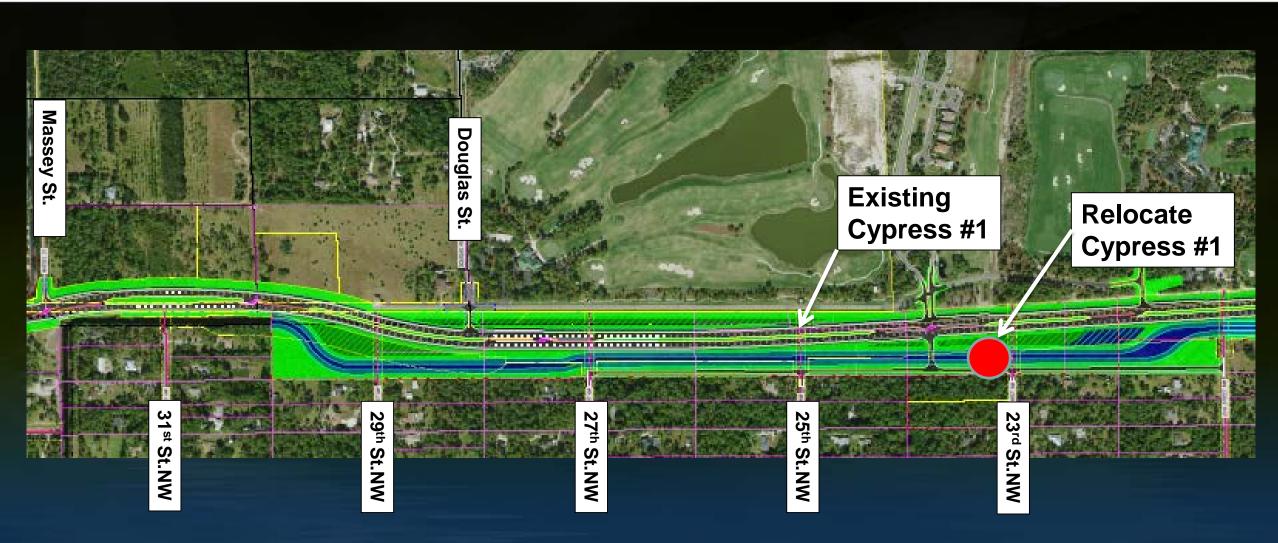

- Project scope includes remotely operable structure
- Coordinated with County to determine timing of expansion and available land for construction
- Selected location is NW 23<sup>rd</sup> St due to availability of land and least impacts to homeowners

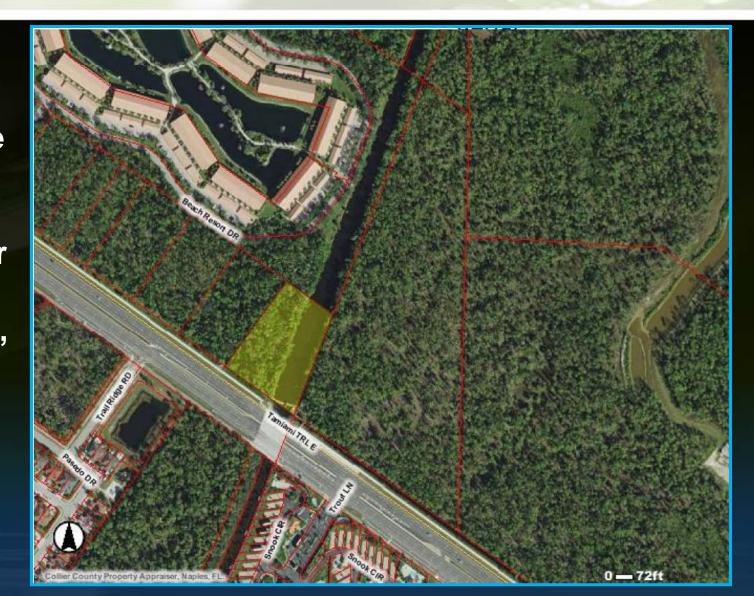

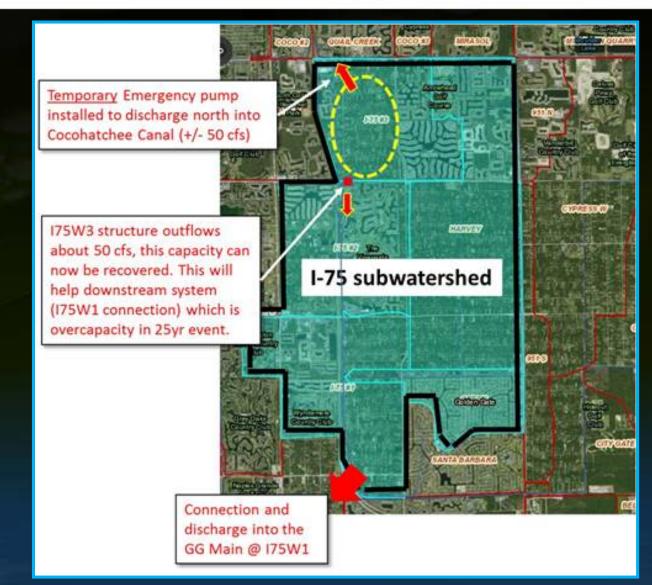
#### **Henderson Creek Land Purchase**

- Needed to secure ownership of land on North side of Henderson Creek 1 Structure
- Board approved negotiating with willing seller
- County negotiated with seller for \$140,000
- Contract executed on Dec 11, 2018 with the County in the amount of \$141,345, which includes estimated closing costs



# I-75 & Cocohatchee Canal Interconnect and Emergency Pump Facility

- Project will provide emergency capability to move floodwater from the northern portions of the I-75 drainage area to the Cocohatchee Canal when capacity becomes available under post storm conditions
- Board approved level of service project in October Board meeting
- Contract executed on Dec 21, 2018 with the County in the amount of \$500,000 to design and construct by end of FY20
