



Filter Marsh Expansion for Improved Water Quality



Existing Filter Marsh Water Quality:

- Mean Total Nitrogen and Total Phosphorus reduced by 16%
- Ammonia concentrations decreased by 41%
- Fecal coliform levels dropped by 20%




Filter Marsh Expansion for Improved Water Quality



Benefits of filter marsh expansion:

- Stormwater treatment
- > Improve water quality
- > Habitat for aquatic wildlife
- > Continued educational value



Recommendation

➤ Provide funding to the Conservancy of Southwest Florida for Filter Marsh Expansion for Improved Water Quality in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.
