

C-44 Reservoir and Stormwater Treatment Area

- Indian River Lagoon South, CERP Project
- C-44 RSTA component
 - 12,408 acres in the current C-44 RSTA boundary
 - Addition of the C-23 to C-44 Interconnect Canal acreage
 - 95.33 acres switched from the Allapattah Complex component
 - 108.53 acres to be acquired from Turner Groves LP


Proposed purchase of lands to construct the C-23 to C-44 Interconnect to the C-44 RSTA

Proposed Acquisition of Turner Groves Property

- Critical land acquisition for project benefits
- Willing seller Turner Groves LP
 - Part of an ornamental tree farm
 - Purchase price of \$5,003,000



Resolution - Acquisition

A Resolution of the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District to acquire land interests containing 108.53 acres, more or less, located in the Indian River Lagoon - South Project, C-44 Reservoir and Stormwater Treatment Area Component, in Martin County, in the amount of \$5,003,000, plus associated costs, for which Ad Valorem funds and/or dedicated funds (Florida Forever Surplus) are subject to Governing Board approval of the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Adopted budget; providing an effective date.
