Agenda Item Background:

The annual Florida Legislative Session concludes with the approval of the General Appropriations Act, the law providing Florida with annual funding to operate. This annual resolution recognizes specific state funding for District projects from the 2020 Legislative Session. The District included this funding in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget which was adopted September 22, 2020. This resolution advises the Secretary of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection of the budgeted appropriations. The annual cycle enables District staff to update the current and prior year carry forward appropriations for project funding through these appropriations. This resolution also authorizes the Executive Director, or Designee, to request distribution of current and prior appropriations through September 30, 2021.
