



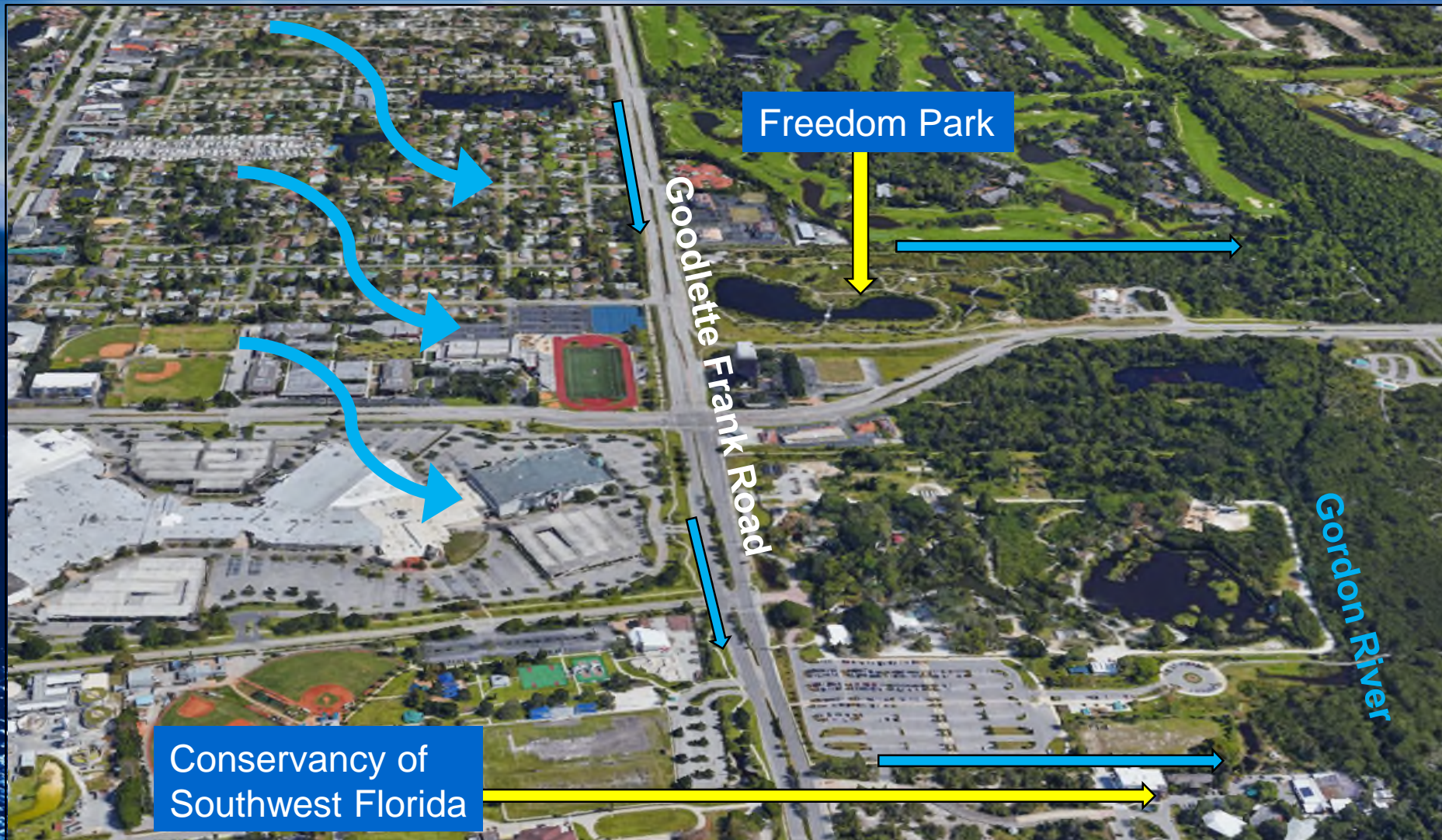

## ➤ Project Benefits

- Increase nutrient removal efficiency
- Expand habitat for aquatic wildlife
- Continue educational value

## ➤ Funding

- Phase 2 cost is \$115,500
- Funds are budgeted and available
- Funding allocation of \$46,200

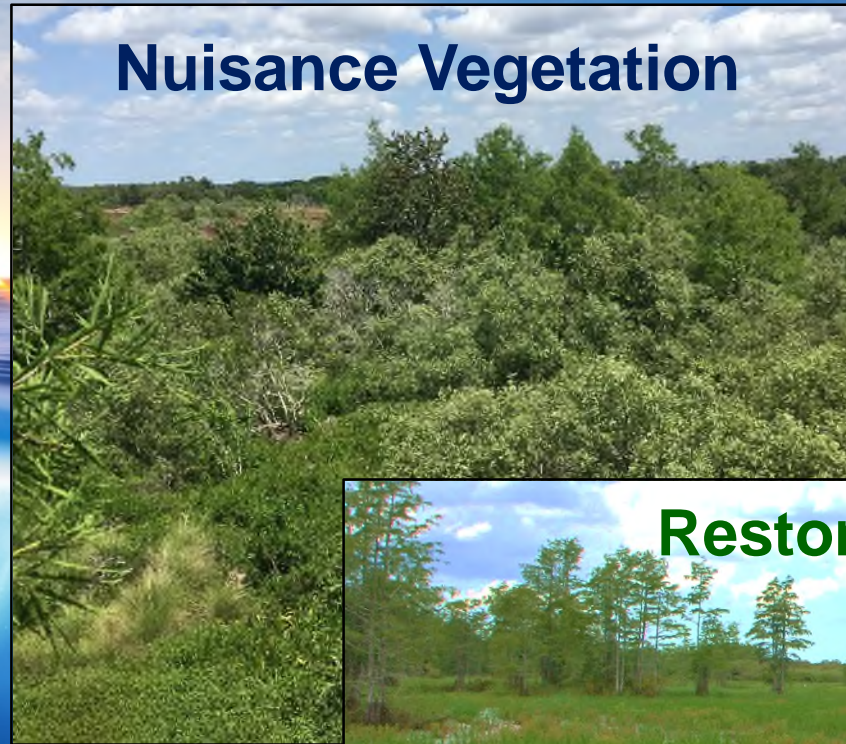




# Ecosystem Restoration

## Restoration Goal

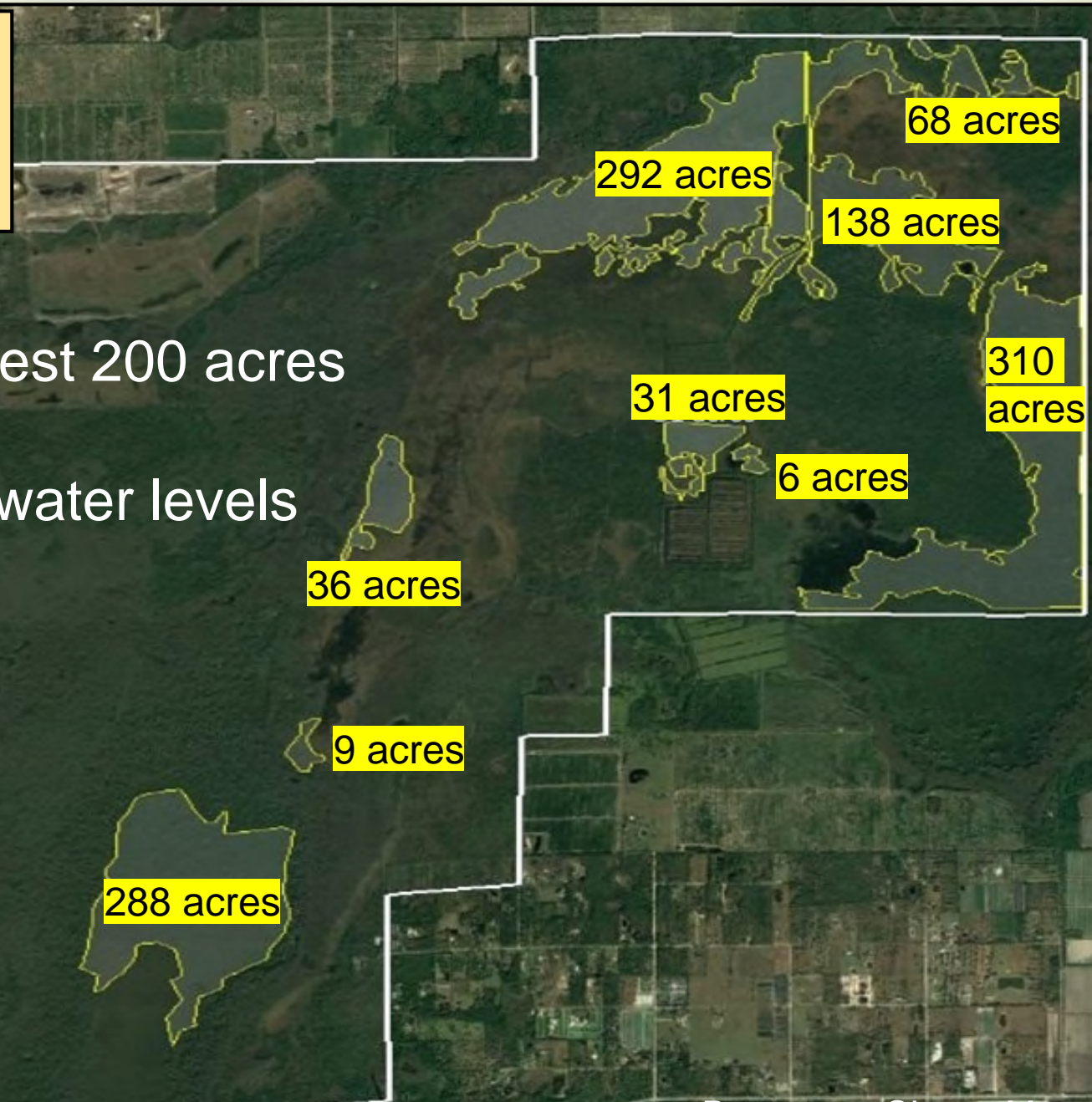






Remaining areas of willow  
extent within Corkscrew  
Swamp Sanctuary's boundary

- Mechanically harvest 200 acres
- Areas depend on water levels







# Ecosystem Restoration

## ➤ Project Benefits

- Restore marsh and prairie areas
- Improve habitat for native wildlife

## ➤ Funding

- Project cost is \$260,000
- Funds are budgeted and available
- Funding allocation of \$100,000
