Budget Development Milestones

≻ November

 November 18 -- Big Cypress Basin Board Meeting – Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Budget Discussion.

> January

- January 15 -- Submit the Districts Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Budget for Legislative review pursuant to section 373.535 Florida Statutes.
 - Distribution includes President of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Chairs of legislative committees and subcommittees with substantive or fiscal jurisdiction over water management districts.
- February 25 -- Big Cypress Basin Board Meeting Provide a Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Budget Update.

> March

• March 1 -- Legislative Comments on Preliminary Budget to the Districts.

≻April

April 22 -- Big Cypress Basin Board Meeting - Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget Update/Discussion.

Budget Development Milestones

≻July

- July 9 -- Big Cypress Basin Meeting for Proposed Millage Rate and Tentative Budget
- July 15 -- Governing Board meeting Fiscal Year 2021-22 Tentative Budget update and Proposed Millage Rates approval.
 - Request Governing Board approval of proposed millage rates for certification to property appraisers.
 - In compliance with Sections 200.065, & 373.536 Florida Statutes.
- Mid July -- Submission of the District's Fiscal Year 2021-22 Draft Tentative Budget to Department of Environmental Protection.

≻August

- August 1 -- Submission of the District's Fiscal Year 2021-22 Tentative Budget for Governor and Legislative review.
- August 26 -- Basin Board meeting to approve the Final Millage Rate and Fiscal Year 2021-22 budget.

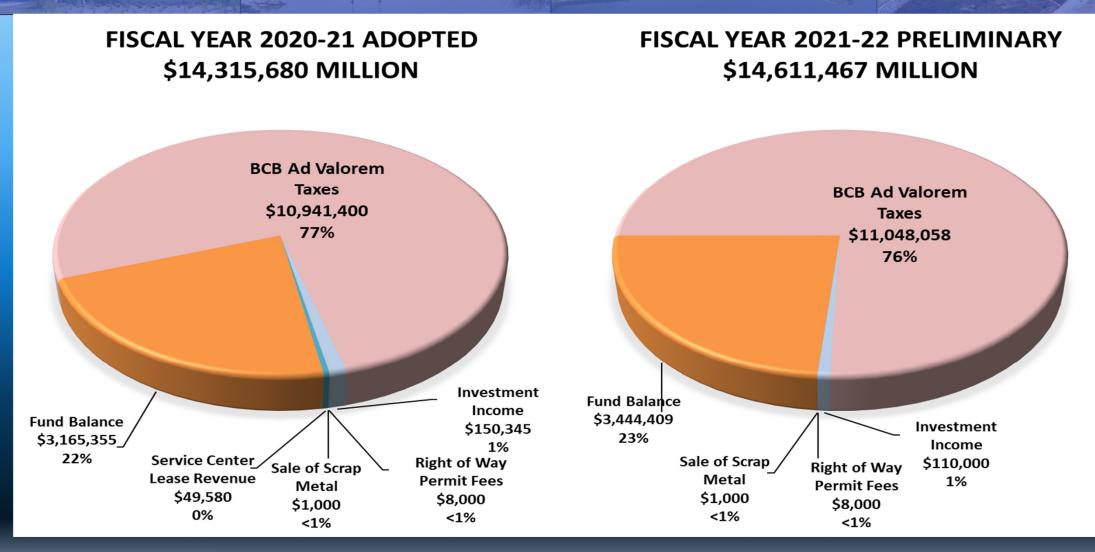


Budget Changes Since November Meeting

- ➤ Big Cypress Basin Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Budget in November was \$14,537,280
 - >\$221,600 increase from the FY2020-21 Adopted budget of \$14,315,680
- ➤ Big Cypress Basin Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Budget submitted in January was \$14,611,467
 - ➤\$74,187 increase is for personnel and benefit costs resulting from an estimated increase in Florida Retirement System (FRS) employer contributions within Flood Control Operations, Modeling & Monitoring Support, BCB Service Center Staff & Facilities and BCB Capital Program Support
- ➤ Big Cypress Basin Fiscal Year 2021-22 Preliminary Revenue updates:
 - > BCB Ad Valorem Taxes: \$106,658 increase (EDR estimates and local housing market growth)
 - ➤ BCB Fund Balance Utilization: (\$32,471) decrease
 - >TOTAL REVENUE CHANGES: \$74,187 increase

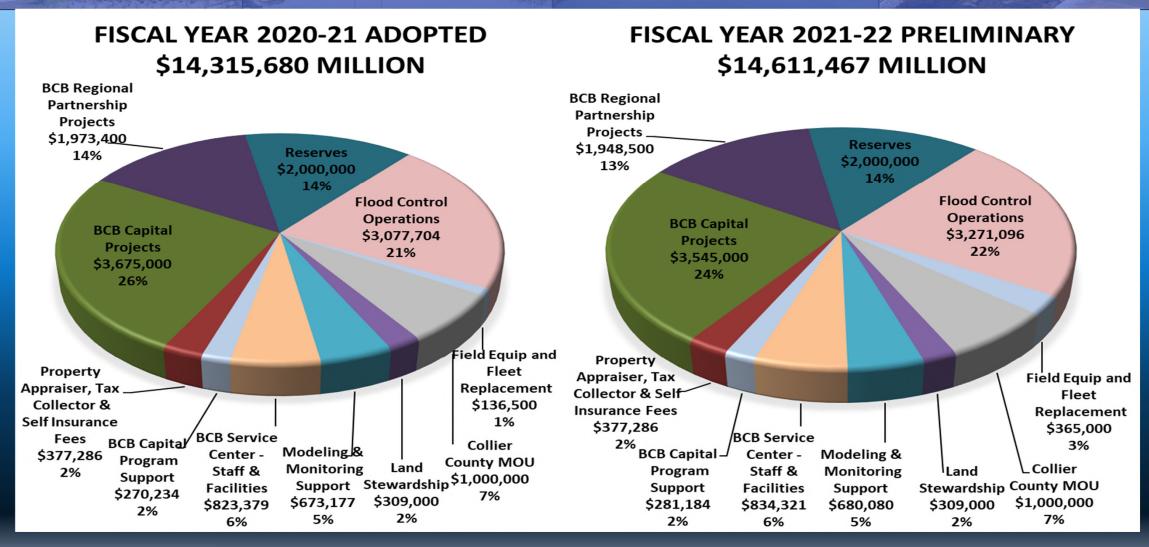


Fiscal Year 2021-22 BCB Revenue Sources





Where the Money Goes (Forecast Categories)



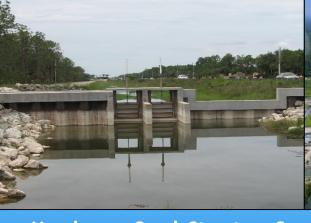
