Ullman, P.G. on October 8, 2018, the District is requesting the following information, in accordance with Section 40E-1.603, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), to complete the application and provide reasonable assurances for permit issuance:

1. Applicants must demonstrate all ownership or all legal control of the properties on which they will conduct water use. Please submit ownership and leases for this permit which should include the folios, owner on record (owner or lessee), acreages, and lease expiration dates per Subsection 2.1.1 of the Applicant's Handbook for Water Use Permits within the South Florida Water Management District. Please provide a spreadsheet listing all current owners and lessees and a corresponding aerials/maps which provides all folios and lessees and owners identified on the aerials/maps.

In accordance with paragraph 40E-1.603(1)(c) F.A.C., if the requested information is not received within 30 days of the date of this letter, this application may be processed for denial, if not withdrawn by the applicant. If additional time is needed, please contact one of the District staff members below with a request for an extension before the 30 day period ends.
