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
Governing Board Funding Guidelines

➤ Eligibility considerations:

- Construction only (October 2016-September 2018)
- Supports mission of the District and/or adopted plan
- Environmental, resource, and community benefits
- Readiness to proceed

➤ Up to 50% (75% for REDI) or proposed funding maximum, whichever is less

Project Type	Funding Maximum Guideline
Alternative Water Supply	\$500,000
Stormwater Management	\$250,000
Water Conservation	\$100,000

➤ 142 total project proposals received

Project Type

- Alternative Water Supply (20)
- Stormwater Management (94)
- ◆ Water Conservation (28)

Considerations: Alternative Water Supply

- Supports goals & objectives of regional water supply plan
- Reduces dependence on traditional sources
- Environmental benefits
- Contributes to Alternative Water Supply development in resource-limited area
- Consistent with Consumptive Use Permit
- Supports ocean outfall legislation
- Multi-jurisdictional
